**(As of now, all the seats are advertised without the fellowships However, fellowships to the candidates selected under the campus seats may be provided subject to availability of funds for Non-NET fellowship scheme from UGC)**

**1. Details of Schools and subjects available for M.Phil./Ph. D. programmes:**

**N.B.:** The University shall admit M.Phil./Ph.D. students through an Entrance Test and interview/viva-voce. However, the following categories of the applicants shall be exempted from the Entrance Test, but they have to apply online on prescribed form before the due date along with fee.

- i) Regularly appointed teachers of this University.
- ii) Teacher Fellow (Under UGC Scheme)
- iii) NET/SLET( Uttarakhand)/ GATE qualified candidates
- iv) M.Phil. candidates of HNB Garhwal University in the concerned subject.

## **2. Eligibility criteria for admission to the M.Phil. and Ph.D programmes:**

- 2.1 Master's degree or a professional degree in the concerned subject or in a cognate or an allied/interdisciplinary subject, declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.
- 2.2 A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

**Note:** Candidates appearing in final semester of qualifying examinations may also apply; however, they should produce the documents of above mentioned eligibility criteria at the time of interview, failing to which their candidature will be rejected.

**3. Admission Process:** The candidates for M.Phil. and Ph.D. programmes will be admitted by two stage process through written test and interview/viva-voce:

- Candidates shall have to go through a written examination consisting of two sections. Section I: Research Methodology (50 marks) and Section II: Subject specific test, based on Post Graduate syllabus of the concerned subject (50 marks). Total marks: 100.
- The question paper will contain 100 (50 from each section) objective type questions (Multiple Choice Questions).
- Please visit the University website [www.hnbgu.ac.in](http://www.hnbgu.ac.in) and [www.hnbgentrance.in/phd/](http://www.hnbgentrance.in/phd/) for the syllabus of postgraduate programs of concerned subject as well as a common syllabus Research Methodology for Entrance Test.
- The students shall be allowed a maximum of two hours time to complete the test.
- Qualifying cut-off marks in Entrance Test: 50% for General; 45% for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently Aabled categories.
- All the candidates who qualify Entrance Test will be called for interview along with the candidates exempted from the written test. Regularly appointed teachers of this University/Teacher Fellow (Under UGC Scheme)/Students who have qualified NET/SLET-Uttarakhand/GATE and M.Phil. candidates of HNB Garhwal University in the concerned subject are exempted from entrance test; but they have to apply ONLINE on prescribed form before the due date along with requisite fee.

- An interview/viva-voce to be organized by the concerned Department of the University when the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted Board of Studies.
- The interview/viva voce shall also consider the following aspects, viz. whether:
  - the candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research;
  - the research work can be suitably undertaken at the Institution/College;
  - the proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.
- The result of M.Phil./Ph.D. Entrance Test shall be valid for admission for 2017-2018 academic session only.
- Allotment of seats in the Campuses and affiliated colleges will be made on the basis of overall merit and preference opted by the candidates.
- Candidates who qualify the written test should bring the hard copy of their on line application (along with all original documents and certificates) at the time of interview.

#### **4. How to apply:**

- Step 1: Apply online for registration through the University website ([www.hnbgentrance.in/phd/](http://www.hnbgentrance.in/phd/))
- Step 2: Generate online challan through login
- Step 3: Deposit the required fee in any SBI branch through print out of online generated challan.
- Step 4: Fill details of challan after two working days through login.
- Step 5: After successful fee confirmation; fill the personal details, upload the photo and signature. Thereafter, fill the educational details.
- Step 6: After verifying the details submit the online application form.

## **8. General Instruction for the applicants:**

- Merely qualifying in the Entrance Test does not guarantee admission in any programme, as admission to particular program is subject to the availability of seats in that program and fulfilling other conditions.
- The result of Entrance Test shall be valid for admission for the current academic session (2017-18) only.
- The medium for written test will be English for subjects under Schools of Sciences (excluding Home Science), Life Sciences, Agriculture and Allied Sciences, School of Management, School of Earth Sciences (excluding Geography, Defense and Strategic Studies) and medium for rest of the subjects in other Schools will be bilingual excluding languages.
- M.Phil. courses are being offered in English and Environmental Plant Biology. The candidates who have done M.Phil. in these subjects from HNB Garhwal University are only exempted from appearing in the Ph.D. Entrance Test in the concerned subjects only but they have to apply online on prescribed form with fee before the last date.
